DENTAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

A dental prophylaxis includes cleaning and polishing your pet's teeth while under general anesthesia. After your pet is anesthetized and the teeth are cleaned, a complete oral exam will be done. At this time it is common to identify a variety of dental problems, including gingivitis, loose teeth, exposed tooth roots, fractured teeth and periodontal disease. It is easiest to treat these disorders at the time of diagnosis to avoid having to anesthetize your pet a second time.
